## HELPING PRESERVE KENNEWICK'S HERITAGE

- ❖ Provide public information and encourage public involvement with historic preservation in the City of Kennewick.
- ❖ Officially recognize excellence in restoring and maintaining important historic properties.
- ❖ Maintain a comprehensive inventory of historic properties in the City.
- ❖ Review proposals that would alter buildings on the City Register.
- ❖ Assist owners with special tax incentive documentation.
- ❖ Review land use documents that affect local historic resources.
- ❖ Maintain a Local Register of Historic Places.

## GOALS OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION



- ❖ Identify, evaluate, and protect properties by documenting buildings for historic significance and eligibility to the Local, State, or National Register.
- ❖ Promote preservation and rehabilitation by providing special tax valuation for owners.
- ❖ Provide other incentives to encourage private owners to restore or redevelop historic structures.
- ❖ Safeguard the heritage of the City that is represented by significant sites, objects, buildings, and structures.
- ❖ Foster civic and neighborhood pride in Kennewick's history.
- ❖ Encourage an identification with the past accomplishments of the City that can serve as a springboard to our future.
- ❖ Reduce land use conflicts by facilitating early identification of potentially significant properties.

The Commission needs volunteers to research and inventory buildings, sites, and locations with potential historic significance.
