**15.36.010: Title:** This Chapter shall be known as the Gas Code of the City and may be cited as such. Any portion of Chapter 15.12 of the Kennewick Municipal Code pertaining to the transmission or use of natural or any type of gas used as a fuel; sale, installation and maintenance of appliances and inspection of such transmission lines and appliances shall be considered a part of the gas code. #### **15.36.100: License - Fees:**

(1) Licenses: The annual fee for the gas installation license shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the first year and twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per year thereafter. A written competency test shall be taken upon the receipt of the first year fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) upon successfully passing the written test with a seventy-five percent (75%) or greater score. The gas license will be issued. Unless revoked or suspended, licenses shall continue in force from January 15 of one year to January 15 of the succeeding year, and shall not be transferable.

(2) Licenses Not Required: The requirements contained herein shall not be construed to limit the right of the gas utility and its authorized employees to render necessary service in the event of an emergency. **15.36.110: License - Display - Nontransferable:** Each licensed gas installer shall display his license upon request by the Building Official or other authorized employees. **15.36.120: Nonliability:** This Chapter shall not be construed as relieving such persons owning, operating, installing, or inspecting any gas piping, appliances or other gas apparatus from liability to anyone injured by any defect therein. Nor shall the City or any agent thereof be held as assuming any such liability by reason of the inspection authorized hereunder or certificate of inspection issued by the Building Official.
